### ~ DIRECTION & PARKING ~

Thanks to the generous support of TD Banknorth, we are located within their Bristol branch on the second floor. An elevator is available for accessibility.

#### Heading East (from Hanover/Lebanon)

Go to Lebanon and take Route 4 East until you get to Danbury. In Danbury, take Route 104 East which goes directly into Bristol. When you come to the traffic light in Bristol (the Jct. of 104 and 3A) you bear to the right on Route 104. North Main Street is about a quarter mile up the street on your left directly across from the town square. Take a left onto North Main St. The TD Banknorth building is the large 3-story brick building on your right.

#### Heading South (from Haverhill area)

Travel the same route that you would take to come to Plymouth (Rts 25, 25a, or 25c), but when you get to the Plymouth traffic circle on Route 25, bear to the right and head down Route 3A which brings you into Bristol. When you get to the light at the junction of Routes 3A and 104, stay straight on Route 104. North Main Street is about a quarter mile up the street across from the town square. Take a left onto North Main St. and the TD Banknorth building is the large 3-story brick building on your right.

#### Heading South on I-93 (from Littleton)

Follow I-93 South to Exit 23 (New Hampton) and bear right off the exit ramp towards Bristol. About 5.5 miles west on Route 104 you come into the downtown. As you approach the town square, you go around the bend and you will take an immediate right onto North Main St.. The TD Banknorth building is the large 3-story brick building on your right.

#### Heading North on I-93 (from Concord)

Follow I93 North to Exit 23 (New Hampton) and bear left off the exit ramp towards Bristol. About 5.5 miles west on Route 104 you come into the downtown. As you approach the town square, you go around the bend and you will take an immediate right onto North Main St.. The TD Banknorth building is the large 3-story brick building on your right.
